Since the very outbreak of the pandemic we are constantly confronted with the question of civil protection involvement during the COVID-19 pandemic. Right at the beginning it must be emphasized that civil protection is not an institution or body. It is the system of tasks and measures aimed at life, health and property protection. They are based on analysis of possible hazards and taking

measures to reduce risks of danger, as well as determination of procedures and operations when eliminating consequences of emergencies. The Act on civil protection in the article 2 par. 2 stipulates that civil protection mission is to protect life, health and property and create conditions for survival during emergencies and declared emergency situation to the extent set by the mentioned act. Civil protection is permanently active. Since the primary information on possible threat of introduction of the COVID-19 to the territory of Slovakia, tasks and measures of civil protection have been executed immediately – provision of notification and information services in particular was concerned by means of which exchange of information on the topical situation in the neighbouring countries was underway and later, in cooperation with other departments, on managing returns of repatriates from preparation of their return to their placement in the

relevant quarantine facility... Read more on pages 4 – 5.
