### **Purpose of the processing defined by specific law**

(Article 13(1)(c) of GDPR or Section 19(1)(c) of Personal Data Protection Act)

Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2017/2226 establishing an Entry/Exit System (EES) to register entry and exit data and refusal of entry data of third-country nationals crossing the external borders of the Member States and determining the conditions for access to the EES for law enforcement purposes, and amending the Convention implementing the Schengen Agreement and Regulations (EC) No 767/2008 and (EU) No 1077/2011,

Act No. 171/1993 Coll. On the Police Force as amended,

Act. No. 404/2011 Coll. On the Residence of Foreigners and On Amending and Supplementing Certain Acts as amended.

### **The period for which the personal data will be stored**

(Article 13(2)(a) of GDPR or Section 19(2)(a) of Personal Data Protection Act)

The period for which the personal data will be stored is defined in Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2017/2226 establishing an Entry/Exit System (EES) to register entry and exit data and refusal of entry data of third-country nationals crossing the external borders of the Member States and determining the conditions for access to the EES for law enforcement purposes, and amending the Convention implementing the Schengen Agreement and Regulations (EC) No 767/2008 and (EU) No 1077/2011, based on which the Ministry of Interior of the Slovak Republic processes personal data.

### **Data subject's rights**

(Article 13(2)(b) of GDPR or Section 19(2)(b) of Personal Data Protection Act)

Requests from the data subject for access to personal data, the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to object to processing, or the right to data portability can be submitted in person, in writing, electronically, signed with a guaranteed electronic signature, or by email ([gdpr@minv.sk](mailto:gdpr@minv.sk)).

The requests must include (except those signed with a guaranteed electronic signature of the data subject) attached copy of ID document (ID card, passport, etc.).
