DEFINITIONS OF APPLIED TERMS

As of 01. August 2011 has been changed a definition of Illegal state border crossing and Illegal stay on a territory of Slovak republic as a result of changes in methodology used for measuring illegal migration within Presidium of Police Force, Bureau of Border and Alien Police.

a) internal border - are sections of the state border of the SR, which represent the common land borders among the member states of Schengen area – what comprises sections of the state border of SR with Austria, Hungary, Czech Republic, Poland and airports for intra-schengen flights,

b) external border – are sections of the state border of the SR, which represent the common land border with non-member state, and airports for external flights (extra-schengen), what comprises **land border** – state border of SR with Ukraine, and **air border** – airport Bratislava, airport Poprad and airport Košice

c) illegal state border crossing – external border (land, air) – foreigner who illegally crossed or tried to cross illegally the state border of the SR, regardless of direction of crossing. It being understood that the time between crossing the state border and apprehension of the person is not more than 48 hours, furthermore this person is apprehended on a territory of SR by police patrol whose task is border control. To same category belongs also cases of readmission, where foreigner is apprehended outside of Slovak territory by authority of another country and is returned to Slovakia by this authority on a basis of readmission agreement. This category includes only specific cases of readmission, when foreigner previously crossed the state border illegally and a time frame between his/her apprehension by authority of another country and illegal crossing of common border is no more than 48 hours.

d) illegal stay on a territory of the SR – foreigner who was found to be illegally present in the territory of the SR, not in compliance with the national legislation, regardless the fact he entered the territory of the SR legally or illegally.

Disaggregation of illegal stay

- inland:

- **after legal entry to the SR** - this group represents foreigners who were apprehended inland for their illegal stay and were previously entered (could enter) to SR legally, but at the time of their control it came out that they are in a country illegally (overstayers),
- **after illegal entry to the SR** - this group represents foreigners who were apprehended inland for illegal stay and were previously entered to SR illegally,
- **after unknown entry to the SR** - this group represents foreigners who were apprehended inland for illegal stay, but there is no evidence that their previous entry to the SR was legally or illegally,

- at the border crossing point at exit from the SR - this group represents foreigners whose illegal stay in the SR was found during border control at BCP on exit from the SR,

- persons apprehended by authorities of other country - this group represents foreigners who were apprehended outside of the Slovak territory by authorities of another country and were returned to Slovak republic on a basis of Dublin Regulation or on a basis of readmission agreements and fulfills the definition of illegal stay on a territory of the SR,

- on internal borders - this category includes third country nationals who illegally crossed or tried to cross illegally internal borders and were apprehended by Slovak police patrol responsible for inland control near border area (internal borders),

e) refusal of entry - this category includes foreigners to whom was formally refused an entry to the SR in accordance with Article 13 of Schengen Borders Code, or in accordance with paragraph 6 Act. No. 48/2002 on Residence of Foreigners,

f) third country national – every person who has no citizenship of European Economic Area,

g) illegal migrant – person apprehended for illegal state border crossing or illegal stay,

h) readmission related to illegal migration – is handing over and taking over of foreigners according to readmission agreements when this person previously illegally crossed state border of Slovak Republic or illegally stayed in a country after illegal entry,

i) application for asylum – foreigner ask for asylum on a territory of Slovak Republic. This category includes also applications for asylum submitted repeatedly, applications submitted in detention centers for foreigners, prisons or children's home for unaccompanied minors etc.

j) visa - Schengen area member state permission or decision, which is requested for transit or entry with assumption of stay on a territory of member state or several member states. Type of visa which can be used follows:

- **airport transit visa (type A)** – permission or decision allowing third country national, which falls under this specific requirement, to enter transit zone off given airport, without possibility to enter to territory of given member state during stop over or crossing between two international flights,

- **short stay visa (type C)** – permission or decision of member state, requested for entry with intended stay in this member state for a period of time not exceeding three months,

- **long stay visa (type D)** - permission or decision of member state, which is requested for entry with intended stay in this member state for a period of time more than three months.

Under responsibility of DBAP Bratislava APU PF Skalica was cancelled. Under responsibility of DAP Banská Bystrica, APU PF Ružomberok and Veľký Krtíš were cancelled. Under responsibility of DBAP Prešov, APU PF Poprad, Stropkov and Rožňava were cancelled.




Overview of persons having crossed the external border legally by the individual border crossing points in 2010 and 2011

Overview of residence permits granted in Slovakia per years








Illegal state border crossing by the Border Control Units




