

Diversity of Participatory Budgeting

- Significant number of municipal cases,
- Expansion of processes with young people,
- 2 regional PB experiences, promoted by the Governments of the Autonomous Regions of the Azores and Madeira,
- 3 national experiences, promoted by the National Government,
- 2 experiences promoted by public universities,
- 2 experiences promoted by professional associations (nurses, accountants),
- 2 experiences promoted by private companies.



Network of Participatory Municipalities

This Network was created in 2014 and currently has around 65 local governments, which are committed to promoting participatory processes.

The technical coordination is the responsibility of the Association Oficina, an NGO.



Methodology

Participation Cycle

Reception of proposals

9 sessions are organized on the whole territory.

The sessions always take in account accessibilities.











1. The participants gather around tables where they present their proposals. Each group has a moderator.



2. The participants discuss the proposals and decide, by voting, which two are considered the highest priority in each group.



3. The two winning proposals from each group are exposed on the wall of the room and presented to all the presents.



4. The participants vote on the proposals presented in plenary and approve those that go on to the next phase of the process - the technical analysis.

The number of proposals approved is proportional to the number of participants in each meeting.





Technical Analysis

Cost: each project cannot exceed 300.000,00 €.

Time: it should be concluded between 24 and 36 months.

Analysis: Meetings are conducted with the proponents of the proposals and visits to the implementation sites are organised.

Maintenance: The costs of maintenance and future management are also evaluated.









Voting

Voting is done by SMS or through the Participatory Budgeting website.

Each participant has 2 votes for different projects.
